DRIVING CHILDREN SAFELY

 Children under the age of 13 should ride in the back seat. This is usually the safest place in a crash.



- Use the right car seat for your child. Children should ride in rear facing infant seats until at least age 1 and 20 lbs. They may ride in forward facing seats until age 4 and 40 lbs. After that, they should ride in booster seats to at least 8 years of age unless they are 4'9" or taller.
- Always use booster seats with lap AND shoulder belts - never use lap belts only!
- Read your car's owners manual and safety seat manual to be sure the seat is installed properly.
- Make sure your child's car seat harness is positioned in the center of their chest (not over the abdomen).

TIRE SAFETY

- Check tires at least monthly for damage.
- Check tire pressure frequently. Measure when tires are cold. See manual for proper inflation.
- Serious injury can result from tire failure due to under inflation, inadequate tread and overloading.

OTHER TIPS

- Always wear your seat belt!
- Adjust head restraints so they are less than 2" from your head and level with your ears (not neck) in a crash.
- Use anti-lock brakes correctly. Apply continuous pressure, do not "pump" them.

Call Us Immediately

Even if you feel fine, still see a doctor. Some injuries are not readily apparent.


IF AN ACCIDENT HAPPENS
